A tragic tale of love, loss and one man's journey from alienation to acceptance.

Synopsis

When Wilhelm Erdinger arrives in the sleepy village of Falters Mill, claiming to want nothing more than to be left alone to pursue a self-sufficient life, the locals are more than happy to oblige.

Against all expectations, his life flourishes, and he discovers both unexpected friendship and love. But as war marches ever closer, it is not the locals' growing antipathy against the German in their midst that threatens to bring his tenuous happiness crashing down, but a dark secret from his past

Discussion points for *Sewing Moonlight*

1. Set against the backdrop of the 1920s and the effects of war and depression, how does the historical setting influence the characters' lives and decisions?
2. If you were in Wilhelm's position, how would you approach building a new life in a foreign place? What challenges do you think you would face?
3. Which moments in the book resonated with you the most emotionally? How did they affect your understanding of the characters?
4. After the conclusion of the story, what do you envision for Wilhelm and the other characters?
